

NEW 2020 Precourse Self-Assessment Instructions

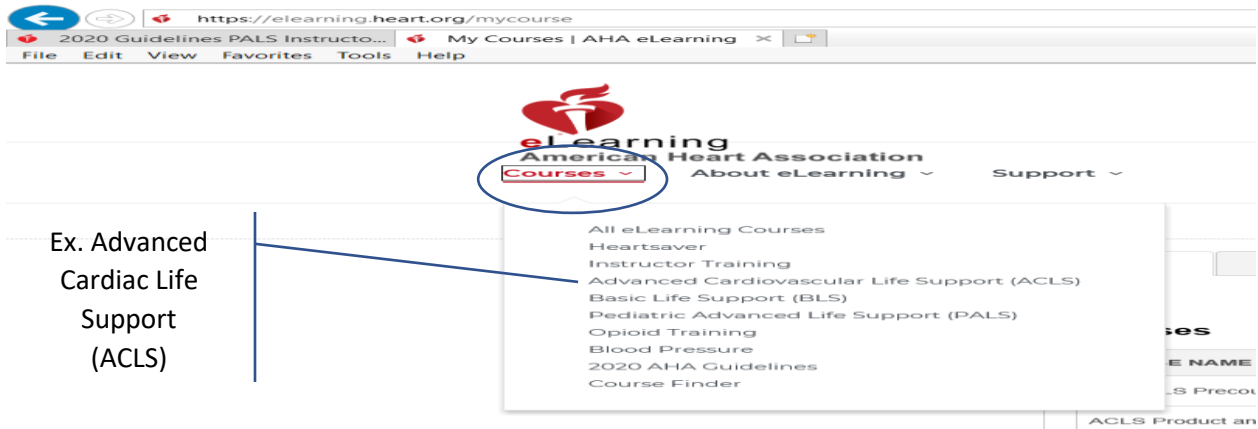
With the release of the new 2020 American Heart Association Guidelines, access to the precourse work has changed. Please review this document carefully as it outlines how to and which course you need to access for your precourse work.

For BLS:

Follow the instruction sheet that comes with your access email

For ACLS or PALS:

- Go to the website: elearning.heart.org
- Log in using your current sign in (should be same as BLS)
 - If new to access, be sure to create a new account using your Penn Medicine email address
- Click on the Courses button, then click on the appropriate filter (Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) or Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS))
